We rode the Capital trail on Friday the 18th of July from Jamestown, but were unable to continue to the river park as we had ridden the Colonial parkway and it was just too hot for us to go the whole length of the trail. It is a very pretty trail at the Jamestown end, and the spur up to the high school is scenic. You have done a great job with the bridges over the wet lands, we were impressed with those. I hope you will soon be able to have signage and mile posts, and even a primitive hand drawn map would be helpful. I hope we will be in the area in another two or three years and be able to see more of the trail. Thanks for sending the directions to us and returning my phone call. If you are ever in western PA please check out some of our trails - we have a goodly number of "Rails to Trails" and I can especially recommend the Youghiogheny river trail as one of the most scenic in the area.
